



LOAN DEFERMENT

If you have a student loan and are currently enrolled at Vermont College of Fine Arts on at least a half-time basis, you are eligible for a loan deferment. VCFA participates in the National Student Clearinghouse, a nationwide central repository for information on the enrollment status of post-secondary education students.

Most students enrolled at participating Clearinghouse schools receive automatic deferments. However, if you are currently enrolled and receive a deferment form from your lender or loan servicer, send your form to the VCFA registrar who will forward it to the Clearinghouse for processing.

If you are currently enrolled and receive a collection letter, **contact your lender or loan servicer** to verify that your deferment has been processed. If it has not, contact the Clearinghouse at **703-742-4200** and ask to speak to a Student Service Representative. The representative will verify your deferment information and, if you are being threatened with default, intervene on your behalf with your lender/servicer to ensure your deferment is processed on a priority basis.
